

## **Uttar Pradesh Transport Department and NIC UP State Unit was felicitated during the Zonal Workshop on Mobile Apps – e-Challan & m-Parivahan at Chandigarh, 10-11 April 2017**

**e-Challan** is an integrated enforcement solution to manage the traffic violations through an Android based mobile app through which an Enforcement Officer challans the vehicles on the road and through web application various activities like compounding fee/tax collection, assigning duty, monitoring etc. can be completed in the office by enforcement wing of transport department and traffic police.

Ministry of Road Transport and Highways & National Informatics Centre, Government of India conducted the 1<sup>st</sup> Zonal Workshop on Implementation of Mobile Apps-e-Challan & m-Parivahan at Chandigarh 10-11 April 2017 to create awareness among stake holders. In this workshop official of Transport Department, Traffic Police and NIC State Units of 12 states (Jammu & Kashmir, Himachal Pradesh, Punjab, Haryana, Chandigarh, Delhi, Rajasthan, Uttar Pradesh, Uttarakhand, Gujarat, Madhya Pradesh and Chhattisgarh) participated.

**Uttar Pradesh is the first State of the country in which integrated e-Challan solution has been successfully implemented in all the 76 RTOs/ARTOs.** In recognition Uttar Pradesh Transport Department and NIC UP State Unit were felicitated during the workshop. Shri Gangaphal, Additional Transport Commissioner Road Safety and IT and Dr. L. R. Yadav, Senior Technical Director & State Transport Project Coordinator, NIC UP received the memento from Mr S. S. Dhillon, IAS Additional Chief Secretary to Government of Haryana, Transport Department.





The workshop concluded with the review of VAHAN 4.0 and SARATHI 4.0 applications which are already running in a number of states. The future scopes as well as new services being offered from these applications were also discussed.
